RECOMMENDATION: CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS IN RENAL HEALTH CARE

RECOMMENDATION: ESRD health care professionals attain at least 5.0 hours of continuing education credits and/or contact hours annually in the area of renal health care. Of the 5.0-hour recommendation, 2.0 hours must be approved for credit by accredited professional health care organization.

Each ESRD provider should utilize continuing education verification forms for tracking purposes.

CRITERIA: ESRD health care professionals (nurses (RN/LPN), social workers, dieticians, and patient care technicians).

RATIONALE: To foster the highest attainable level of patient care in the ESRD setting, continuing education serves to validate ongoing qualification and knowledge for practice in a renal health care setting. It also encourages the maintenance of up-to-date knowledge base in renal health care.
